- Strive to promote competitive merit and excellence as the sole guiding criterion in all academic and other matters relating to students.

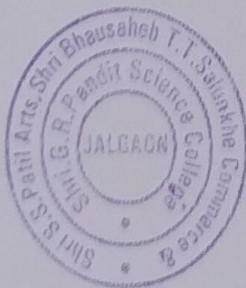
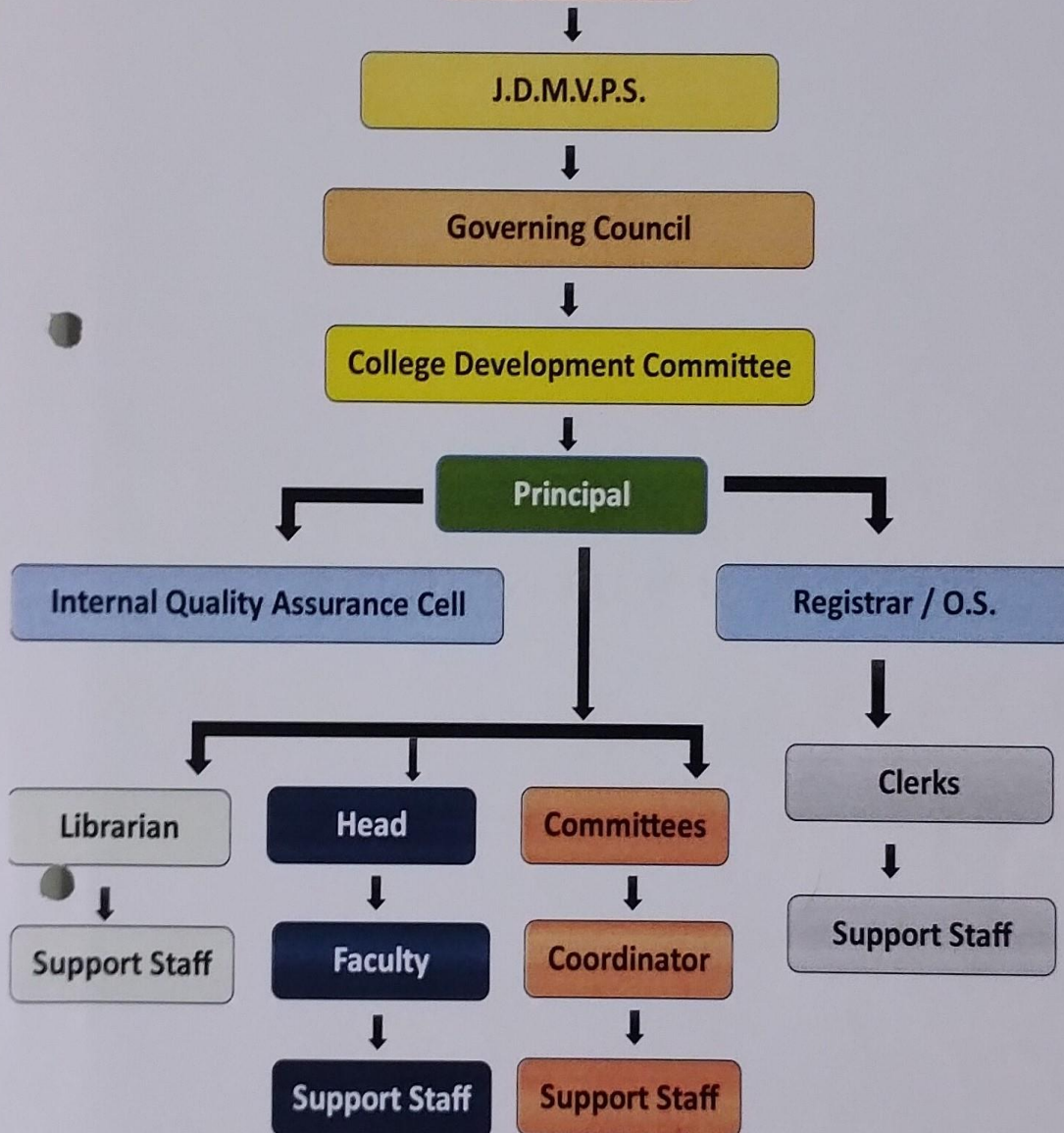
14. Organization Chart:-

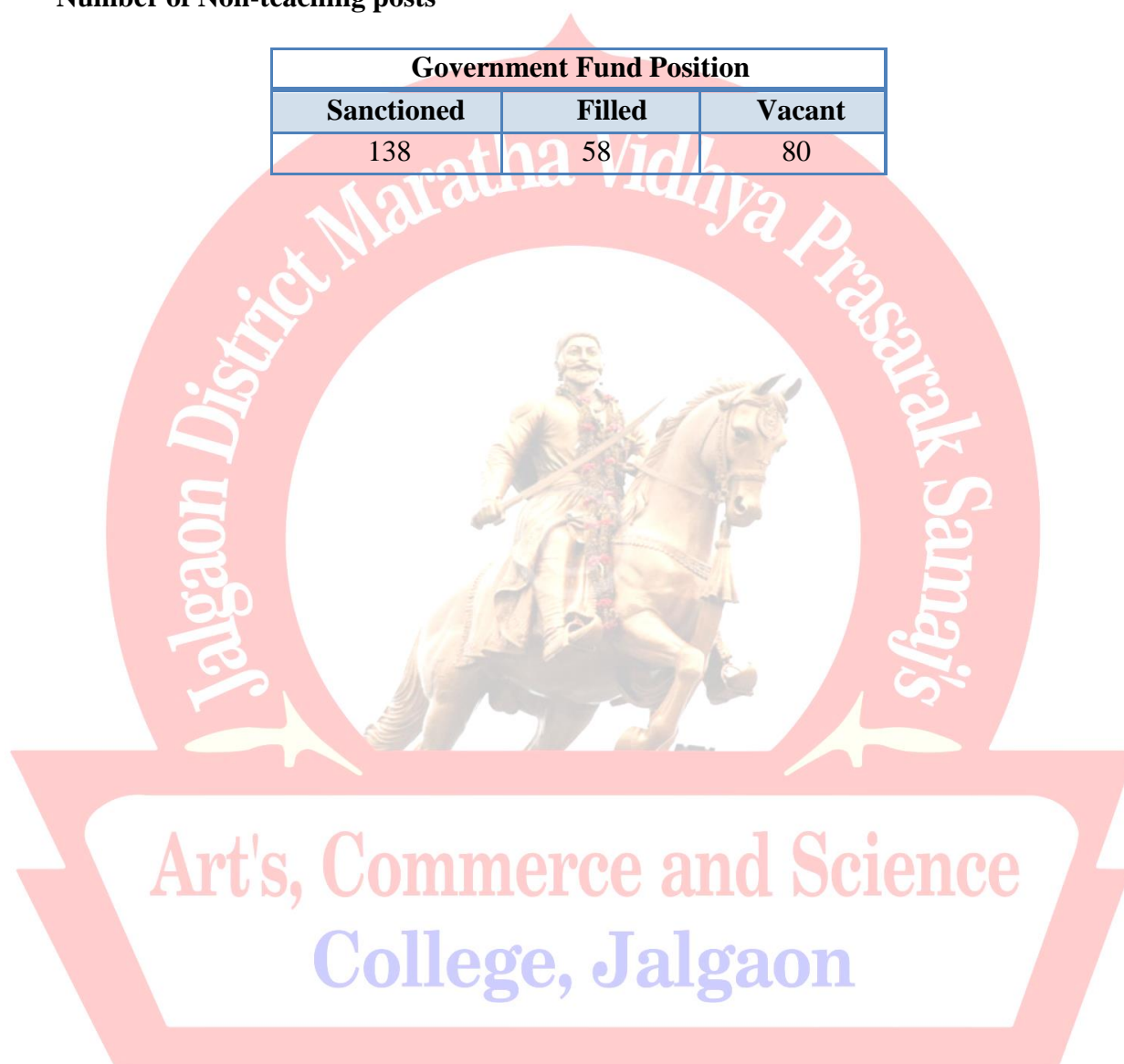
