Objectives-

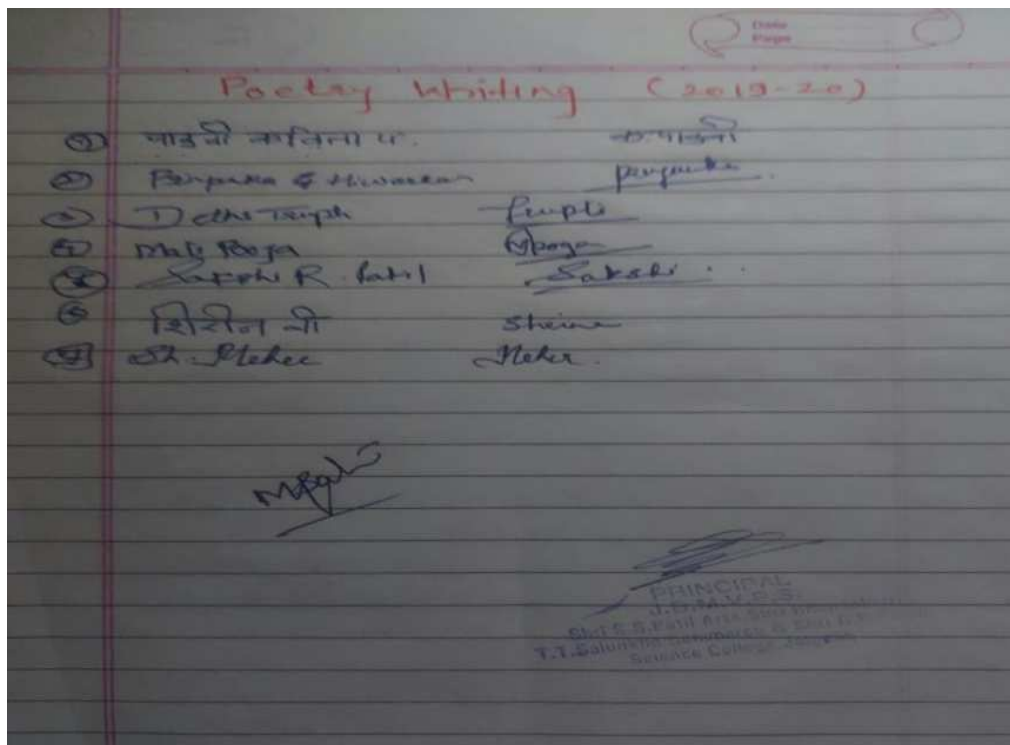
- 1 To provide a platform for students to express their feelings in the form of poetry.

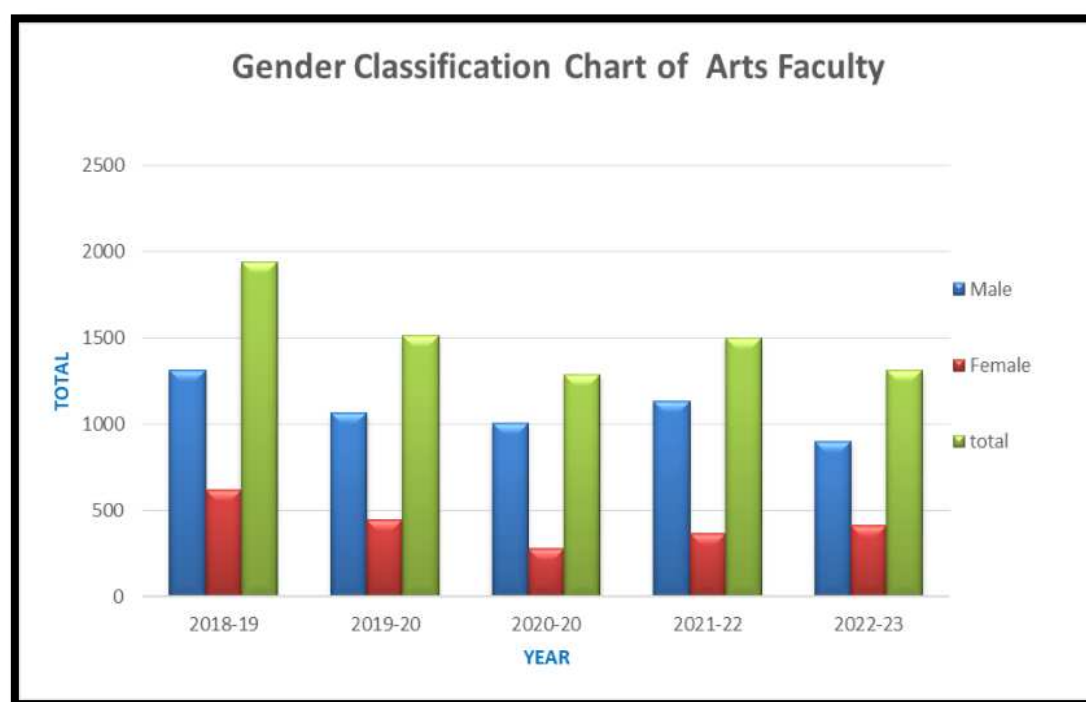

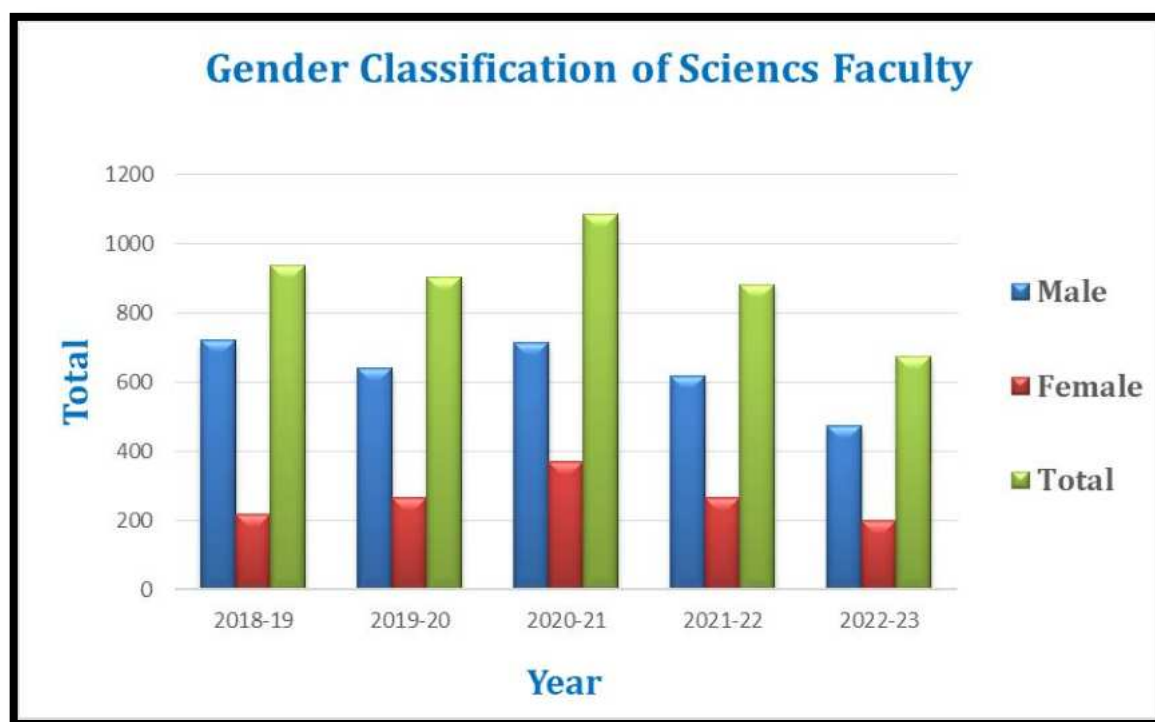

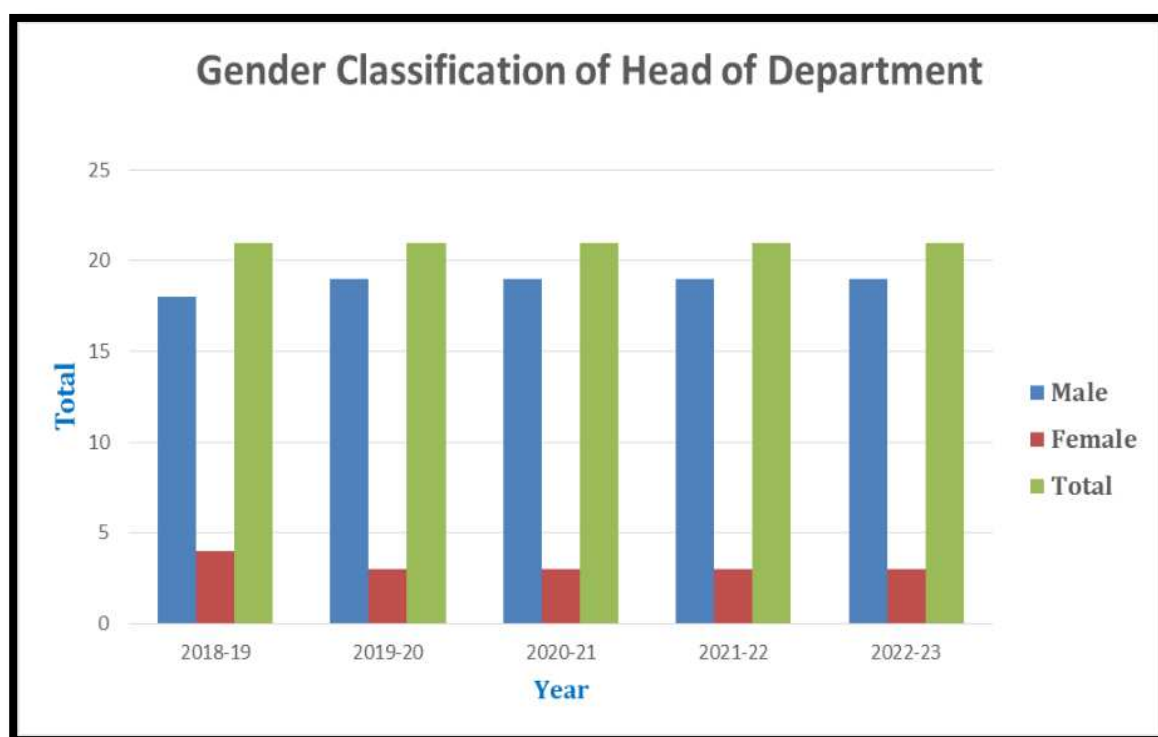
